
Installation Detail

Vitralis - VGB Venetian Glass Brick mix Mortex with water and 1 kg of Weldcrete per 20 kg bag to form a thick paste, and use within three minutes. Apply the mortar with a trowel, maintaining joint thickness below 10 mm. Lay the bricks in a stretcher bond pattern, wiping off excess mortar immediately with a clean, damp cloth. Avoid using any acid-based cleaners during the process.
